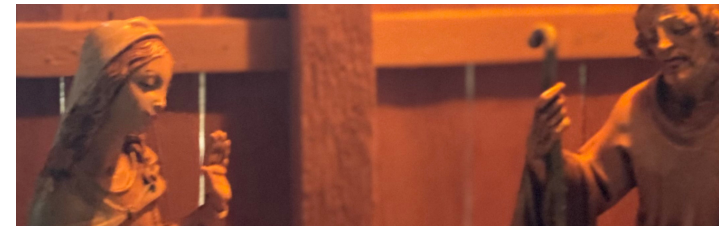
SUNDAYS IN DECEMBER
