HISTORY of our WINDOWS

In 1971, Conrad Schmitt Studios of Milwaukee designed and installed our beautiful stained glass windows. The window on the left depicts Creation. We can see the Tree of Life with its green leaves and the world globe from which it grows. The central window portrays the life, death, and resurrection of Christ. The ancient "Chi Rho" monogram of Christ is visible in the lower portion, a large cross fills the center and the phoenix rises out of the ashes near the top of the frame. The window on the right reflects the final Consummation - the coming of God's Kingdom. Our campaign theme, "Making All Things New" was inspired by this window's depiction of Rev. 21:1-8.
